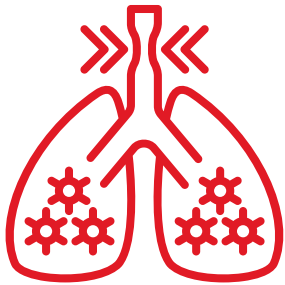

BREATHING / CHOKING



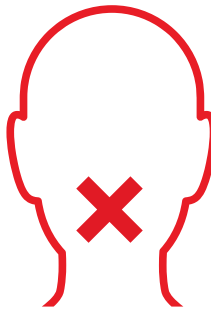
HAVE AN ALLERGIC
