The Georgia Peace Officer Standards and Training Council hereby Orders, and Respondent hereby agrees, to the following terms:

1.

The Revocation of the Respondent's Peace Officer Certification in the State of Georgia is Waived.
All Certifications retained and / or obtained by the Respondent shall be placed on a term of Probation for a

period of 12 months, to begin October 26, 2012 and upon payment of applicable probation supervision and monitoring costs (\$120.00 per year).

Additional conditions are as follows: None

2.

During the period of Probation, Respondent shall not violate any law of this State or of the United States, or any rule or policy of the Georgia Peace Officer Standards and Training Council, nor any rule or regulation of the Respondent's employing agency. Should Respondent be arrested for any criminal offense during the period of probation, Respondent's certification shall be immediately suspended pending disposition of the criminal case.

Respondent acknowledges that he/she has read this Consent Order, and understands the terms and conditions described herein. Respondent further understands that he/she has the right to a hearing in this matter, and waives such right by freely, voluntarily, and knowingly entering into this Consent Order.

4.


As evidenced by his/her signature affixed below, Respondent agrees to abide by all laws of the State of Georgia, the rules

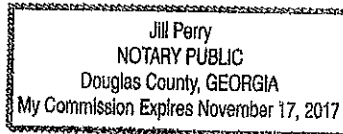



PROBABLE CAUSE COMMITTEE RECOMMENDATION TO COUNCIL

CASE NO. 006-711-01-13

1. Said Individual is Certified (Jailer).
2. Said Officer was employed with the most recent law enforcement unit on 02/06/10.
3. Said Officer is currently employed by a law enforcement unit.

CASE SUMMARY

On or about 10/23/12, the Officer was involved in a domestic dispute with his/her Spouse. Documentation shows that the Spouse woke up the Officer to "address" feces he/she found on the floor in their 2 year old's bedroom. The Officer woke up the Child to make him/her clean the floor. The Spouse "became upset and did not want their two year old to pick up the droppings on the floor." He/she attempted to enter the Child's bedroom and the Officer held the door nearly closed. The Spouse "began reaching [his/her] arm through a small crack in the door." The Spouse left the residence and went to the local police department to file a report. The Spouse claimed he/she "sustained several bruises on [his/her] arm from [the Officer] pushing and shoving [him/her]." Officer G documented he/she saw "small bruises" on the Spouse's arm. When asked by responding officer's, the Officer "denied making any physical contact with [the Spouse]." The Officer was arrested and charged with Simple Battery (FVA), Battery (FVA), and Cruelty to Children 3rd Degree. This arrest was reported to POST by the Officer, as required.

On or about 10/26/12, the Officer voluntarily resigned from the Agency.

On or about 01/19/13, the Officer was hired by Agency C as a Jailer.

On or about 01/28/13, the Officer plead Nolo Contendere to Disorderly Conduct and all other charges were Nolle Prossed. The Officer was sentenced to 6 months probation, 40 hours community service, and \$300 fine.

As of 04/24/13, the Officer is still employed with Agency C as a Jailer.

DISCIPLINARY HISTORY

1. On or about 06/30/10, the Officer was reprimanded for Tardiness.
2. On or about 07/26/10, the Officer was suspended 8.5 hours for Insubordination, AWOL, and Residence Telephone/Address.
3. On or about 07/10/12, the Officer was reprimanded for Conduct Unbecoming, after being involved in a physical struggle/altercation with a co-worker.

VIOLATION

It is hereby asserted this individual is in violation of the following sections of O.C.G.A. 35-8-7.1 (6);(7);(8)(a):
